



NEDAC Growth & Success

Please do not hesitate to reach out if you have any suggestions, ideas, or if you simply wish to reconnect.



NEDAC Scholarship Program

This SCHOLARSHIP/FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM has awarded 250 scholarships since year 2016 when this program was launched and we are determined to continue with 60 scholarships this year with an aim to increase the number up to 80 in the following year.

The current tuition fee structure at NED University is as below:

CAD 700.00 for First Year and CAD 400.00 FOR Second ,Third & Fourth Year.

Funds Needed for 2023

First Year Engineering Students - 15 => \$700 x 15 = \$10500

2nd/3rd & Final Year Students - 45 => \$400 x 45 = # 18000

Total Amount to raise = \$ 40500

Toronto, August 25, 2023 — The NED Alumni Association Canada (NEDAC) is pleased to announce a significant meeting held on August 25, 2023, between its key office bearers and the Consulate General of Pakistan Mr. Khalil Ahmed Bajwa in Toronto at . The purpose of the meeting was to foster collaboration, discuss potential initiatives, and strengthen the ties between the Pakistani diaspora and the Consulate. The delegation from the NED Alumni Association Canada (NEDAC) included prominent members of the executive team:

The Consulate General of Pakistan in Toronto, Mr. Khalil Bajwa warmly welcomed the delegation from the NED Alumni Association Canada. The meeting provided an excellent opportunity for both parties to engage in an open and constructive dialogue, reflecting their shared commitment to promoting educational, economic and cultural exchanges between Pakistan and Canada.

During the meeting, the two sides discussed various avenues

of cooperation, emphasis was given on following key points:

Collaboration Between Canadian and Pakistani
 Universities: The Consulate General is synced with the
 notion and assured to facilitate academic collaborations
 and exchange programs that promote knowledge sharing,
 research partnerships, and cultural exchange, enriching
 the educational experience for students from both
 countries.

- Technological Advancement and Innovation in the IT sector: NED Alumni Association Canada is looking forward to continuing discussions on an ongoing basis on future projects, particularly those that may enhance the collaboration in IT applications / research at NED University of Engineering and Technology (NEDUET). The delegation expounded a high level plan floating around an idea of engaging prominent faculty members of Pakistani origin working in Canadian Universities to help universities backhome. It is apprised to the Consulate General that his contribution in such projects would have a significant impact on these initiatives and success of projects.
- Student Direct Stream Program: Potential of "Student Direct Stream Program" is highlighted by the NEDAC delegation and emphasis is put on creating awareness in youth back home about this Canadian Government's Program that also allows qualifying students to target vocational Training Courses offered by Canadian Institutes / Colleges. NEDAC delegations requested the Consulate General to talk to respective authorities to start the Qarze-Hasna kind of scheme for middle class families to fulfill the mandatory requirement of full payment of tuition for the applicant's first year of study.
- Community Reachout: The Consulate General emphasised on the importance of reaching out to the Pakistani Community and requested NEDAC to play its role to integrate the community in Toronto and beyond to fostering cultural exchange and promoting economic activities. The NED Alumni Association Canada expressed its dedication to contributing to the betterment of the Pakistani community in Canada.

The Consulate General of Pakistan, Mr. Khalil Ahmed Bajwa, acknowledged the invaluable role that diaspora organizations like the NED Alumni Association Canada play in strengthening bilateral relations and fostering understanding between nations. The Consulate General also appreciated the Association's commitment to promoting a positive image of Pakistan in Canada.

Both parties agreed to continue the dialogue and explore avenues for collaboration that align with their shared objectives. The meeting concluded with a sense of optimism and mutual enthusiasm for future endeavors.
